- Assist with clean up and repair projects
- Comfort and encourage those who are affected by a disaster
- Act immediately and effectively

1. Audio Visual

- To maintain a biblical approach to worship that is honoring to God and that relies on the scriptures as the standard of truth and conduct for the Christian
- To encourage an attitude of expectation in the congregation, where the realization of God's presence through worship creates excitement and opens hearts to receive the message from the Word of God

- It is expected that all Worship Choir members will possess a positive, team-centered attitude and exhibit a higher level of spiritual calling, year-round commitment, and musical gifting that is required to serve in this ministry.
