Please note: Ministries with an \* beside them require a background check.

#### Children's Ministry\*

Teach children the word of God, how it applies to their life, and have fun in the process.

#### **Community Outreach & Visitation Ministry\***

Spread the gospel, establish a new relationship and to encourage a personal relationship with Christ; as well as enhance fellowship and worship.

#### **Disaster Relief Ministry\***

Provide assistance to those in the community, state, nation and other parts of the world to meet the physical and spiritual needs of those impacted by a disaster.

#### **Drama Ministry**

Proclaim the word of God through attracting those with drama gifting who have the desire to understand the Word of God in a form other than written or verbal for the mission of praising God, edifying believers, and evangelizing unbelievers.

#### First Baptist Christian Academy\*

Train scholars (pre-k through 12<sup>th</sup> grade) in the way of life presented in the Scriptures while giving them a safe and nurturing learning/academic environment. (**NOTE**: Volunteers support the Academy staff.)

#### Flowers & Decorating Ministry

Provide appropriate decor for the halls, sanctuary, foyer, and event areas as needed to enhance the worship experience for members and guests.

# **Greeters Ministry**

Make everyone feel welcome by greeting them with a smile and providing necessary information.

#### **Health Ministry\***

To promote good health and safety among church attendees.

### **Helping Hands Care Team\***

Helping church families during their time of need (yard work, debris clean-up, light household chores, miscellaneous maintenance/repairs, holiday decorating, etc.).

#### **Hospitality & Fellowship Ministry**

Serve the body of the church in a variety of events with food service involvement, i.e., Spring Fling, picnics, Thanksgiving, etc.

# Jail & Prison Ministry\*

Teach inmates the Word of God and the importance of obedience to it. Lead receptive inmates to Jesus Christ and eternal life. To produce better citizens, better husbands or wives, and give them hope and support and to give them personal peace in a time of personal trouble.

# Men's Ministry (Men of Valor & Purpose – MVP)

Glorify God and lead, challenge and encourage men to be like Christ and to lead their families by example. Encourage cooperative work with other churches and groups, which are dedicated to the furtherance of God's Kingdom.

# **Music Ministry**

- The Audio/Visual Ministry is comprised of like-minded people who are highly skilled, knowledgeable, and technically gifted individuals who are motivated by the smooth functioning of all worship services and church events in a vitally important "behind-the-scenes" support role for the Music Ministry and other church ministries that require audio/visual support.
- The Praise Band is comprised of like-minded people who are highly skilled, well-experienced, and musically gifted instrumentalists and singers that believe that God inhabits the praises of His people through playing instruments and singing in weekly worship services. It is a place where they can share their instrumental, vocal, and spiritual gifts, be an integral part of the worship experience, and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ through using their instruments and vocal talents in a contemporary worship service setting.
- The Worship Choir is comprised of like-minded people who believe that God inhabits the praises
  of His people through choral music and other expressions of worship. It is a group for believers
  to share their vocal and spiritual gifts, be an integral part of the worship experience, and share
  the Gospel of Jesus Christ through song and praise while helping lead the congregation in
  corporate worship.

### **Prayer Ministry**

Intercessory prayer group meets to lift up in prayer those who have requested prayer for various needs including salvation, illness, family decisions, etc. Develop a deep desire within the congregation to seek God's wisdom in every part of life.

#### **Preschool Ministry\***

Pray over, pray with, love and teach God's word to our babies through 4-year-olds respectively. Help build a foundation of biblical concepts that will grow into a relationship with Jesus Christ.

#### **Senior Adult Ministry\***

Provide opportunities for Christian fellowship and growth, mission action and outreach to senior adults of our church and community.

#### **Student/Youth Ministry\***

Reaching, teaching, engaging and equipping students in the Middle and Senior High Schools. Enabling, equipping and empowering teens to live in a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

# **Sunday School (Bible Community Groups) Ministry\***

Engage people in Biblical community through open, ongoing Bible study groups that reach people for Christ, teach foundational Biblical content to all age groups, minister to members and prospects and mobilize people to serve.

#### **Transportation Ministry\***

Transport church members and guest to and from church functions or church-related activities.

# **Upward Sports Ministry\***

Reach Palm Coast residents who don't attend church or know the Lord as their personal savior. Sports programs bring them into the church where scripture is shared, and the gospel is presented.

# **Ushers Ministry**

Represent the church in a very visible way and help set the tone in preparation for Christian worship service. Serve as a host, welcoming members, visitors and those needing special assistance or directions to church associated venues and resources.

#### Vacation Bible School (VBS) Ministry\*

Children of various ages participate in a gospel-centered focus time on games, Bible Study, Missions and music, all to help lead children in knowing and responding to Jesus Christ's love for us. (**NOTE**: Event held annually in July.)

#### Watch Team Ministry\*

Ensure a safe and secure environment for staff and attendees of the church.

#### **Women on Mission**

Support missions financially, pray for missions and missionaries, learn about missions, engage in mission actions and participate in the work of the church.

#### **Women's Ministry**

To raise up Godly women to be exactly who God desires them to be in their roles as wives, single women, mothers, friends, leaders, and servants of Christ and one another. The goal is to exemplify the woman modeled in Titus 2:3-5.
